

HAP PARKER FAMILY AQUATIC CENTER RULES

1. All persons entering the facility for any reason must have a season pass or pay a daily fee.
2. Children age 7 and under must be accompanied by a person age 14 and over.
3. Riders must be at least 48" tall to use big waterslides.
4. All children who are not toilet trained shall wear tight fitting rubber or plastic pants. (For example: Huggies "Little Swimmers".)
5. Outside food and drinks may not be brought in to the Family Aquatic Center.
6. Proper swim attire must be worn at all times. All apparel containing COTTON including street clothes, t-shirts, cut-off shorts, mesh shorts, leotards, underwear, etc MAY NOT be worn in the pool.
7. Flotation devices are prohibited (i.e. rafts, water wings or inflatables). Lifejackets that are stamped with US Coast Guard approval are allowed.
8. Patrons exiting the Family Aquatic Center will be required to pay the daily admission fee to re-enter the facility. Does not apply to season ticket holders.
9. Smoking is not allowed anywhere within the Family Aquatic Center boundaries.
10. Lockers are provided for you convenience. Bring your own lock for security.
11. Patrons are expected to review more specific rules posted by the Illinois Department of Health at the Family Aquatic Center.
12. The Rantoul Recreation Department/Aquatic staff reserves the right to dismiss any patron not abiding by facility rules, acting in an unsafe manner or inhibiting the enjoyment of other patrons.
13. Refunds will not be given to any patron at any time.
