

ORDINANCE NO. 3-07-2083

**AN ORDINANCE
CHANGING THE NAME OF CERTAIN STREETS, AVENUES AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES**

WHEREAS, under and pursuant to Section 11-80-19 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-80-19), the corporate authorities of each municipality may name originally and then may change the name of any street, avenue, alley or other public place within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the area formerly known as Chanute Air Force Base, Rantoul, Illinois (“**Chanute**”) is located within the corporate limits of the Village of Rantoul, Champaign County, Illinois (the “**Village**”) but was subject to the exclusive and partial jurisdiction of the United States of America (the “**USA**”) until its closure on September 30, 1993 and the relinquishment and retrocession of the exclusive and partial jurisdiction of the USA over Chanute by the acceptance thereof by the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village (the “**Corporate Authorities**”) now deem it necessary, desirable and in the best interest of the Village to change the name of certain parts of streets, avenues or other places within the corporate limits of the Village, including one of which is on Chanute, as originally named and/or previously changed to be named.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the following parts of streets, avenues and other public places located within the corporate limits of the Village, including one of which is one Chanute, as originally named and/or changed to be named, as shown on the attachments hereto, are hereby changed to be named as set forth below:

| North Perimeter Road | to | Veterans Parkway |


Section 2. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to provide a certified copy of this Ordinance together with the attached map showing the changes in the names hereby made to the County Clerk, the election authority having jurisdiction of the area in which the names of such parts of streets, avenues and other public places are named and/or changed, and to the post office branch serving such area, by certified or registered mail.

Section 3. That the proper officers, employees and agents of the Village are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to do all such acts and things and to execute and deliver all documents and instruments as may be necessary to carry out the intent and accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance in accordance with its terms.

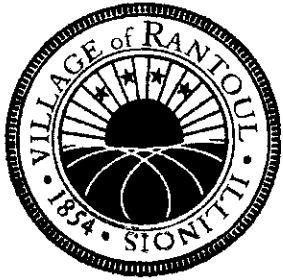

That this Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after the County Clerk and the post office branch serving the area in which the names of such parts of streets, avenues and other public places have been changed pursuant to this Ordinance have been notified of the same as provided in Section 2 hereof.



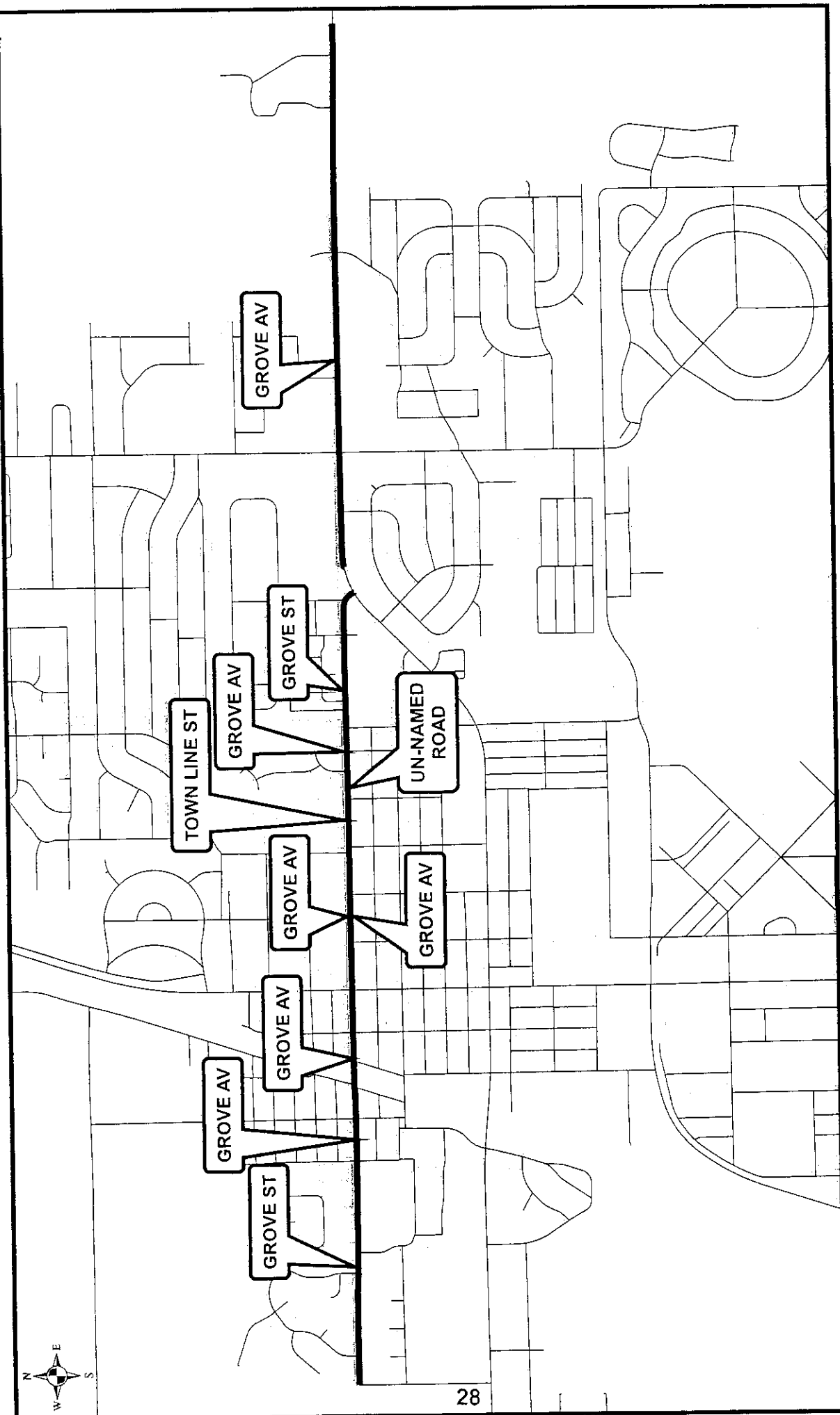
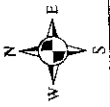

Labels Depict which name and suffix were given to Grove at time of platting.

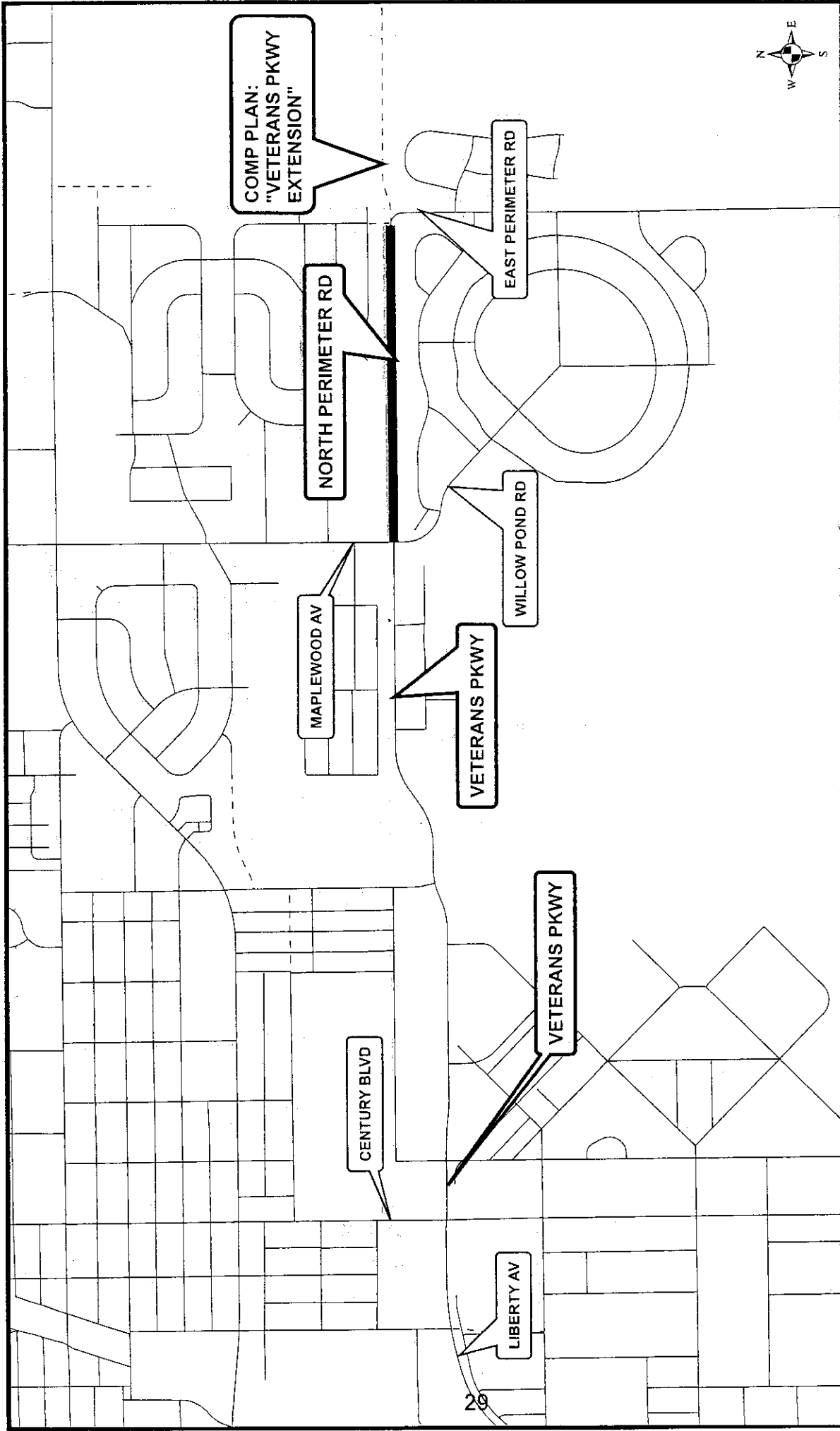
— Roadway Hereby Named Grove Avenue
