

Attachment F: General Insurance and Licensing Requirements

Insurance

The Contractor shall at all times during the Contract maintain in full force and effect Employer's Liability, Workmen's Compensation, Public Liability and Property Damage Insurance, including contractual liability coverage and shall make Village of Rantoul a certificate holder of any such insurance. The certificates shall contain the following express obligation:

"This is to certify that the policies of insurance described herein have been issued to the insured for whom this certificate is executed and are in force at this time. In the event of cancellation or material change in a policy affecting the certificate holder, thirty (30) days prior written notice will be given to the certificate holder."

For the purpose of the Contract, the Contractor shall carry the following types of insurance in at least the limits specified below:

Workers Compensation Insurance:

1. State: Statutory
2. Applicable Federal (e.g., Longshoreman's): Statutory
3. Employer's Liability: \$ 500,000.00
4. Errors and Omission Insurance with a minimum of \$1M per claim/\$2M aggregate

General Liability Insurance:

1. General Aggregate \$ 1,000,000.00
2. Products-Completed Operations Aggregate \$ 1,000,000.00
3. Personal and Advertising Injury \$ 1,000,000.00
4. Each Occurrence (Bodily Injury and Property Damage) \$ 1,000,000.00
5. Property Damage liability insurance shall provide Explosion, Collapse and underground coverages where applicable.
6. Excess or Umbrella Liability:
 - a. General Aggregate \$ 2,000,000.00
 - b. Each Occurrence \$ 2,000,000.00
7. Contractual Liability:
 - a. Bodily Injury:
 - i. Each Person \$ 1,000,000.00
 - ii. Each Accident \$ 1,000,000.00
 - b. Property Damage
 - i. Each Accident \$ 1,000,000.00
 - ii. Annual Aggregate \$ 1,000,000.00

8. Contractor's Pollution Liability \$ 1,000,000.00

Automobile Liability (including hired and non-owned vehicles):

1. Bodily Injury:
 - a. Each Person \$ 1,000,000.00
 - b. Each Accident \$ 1,000,000.00
2. Property Damage:
 - a. Each Accident \$ 1,000,000.00
3. MCS 90 Endorsement on Vehicle Insurance: Statutory

To the extent permitted by law, all or any part of any required insurance coverage may be provided under a plan or plans of self-insurance. The coverage may be provided by the Contractor's parent corporation.

Licensing

All Bidders must be Contractors, Licensed to perform work in this RFP in the State of Illinois.
